The Achenbach's holdings are comprised of more than 90,000 prints, drawings, photographs, and artist's books that document European, American, and Asian graphic arts from the 15th century to the present. The Achenbach is among the largest and most comprehensive graphic arts collections in the western United States.

## The Achenbach and the AGAC

## Membership Levels

AGAC annual membership is offered at the following levels\*:

### Member: \$250

Includes: group tours of select FAMSF exhibitions; group visits to Bay Area galleries, museums, artist studios, etc; periodic bulletins and newsletters; annual membership meeting in June.

### Contributor: \$500

All of the above, plus: priority admission to limited-attendance Achenbach events, including travel opportunities.

### Advocate: \$1,000

All of the above, plus: a behind-the-scenes tour of the Achenbach's historic collection of works on paper, including the paper conservation lab; priority notice for the AGAC travel program, which may include tours of private collections.

### Patron: \$2,500

All of the above, plus: letters of introduction to two works on paper departments at out-of-area museums; an informal consultation by an Achenbach curator providing general advice regarding starting or building your private collection, or an informational consultation with a paper conservator on best practices for displaying and preserving your private collection. Your private collection must be located within 60 miles of the Legion of Honor for an in-person consultation.
